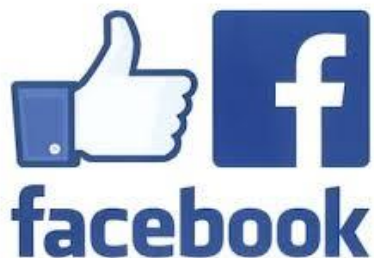
On the evening, we will have time allocated to see your child's classroom teacher to discuss their reports if you wish to.

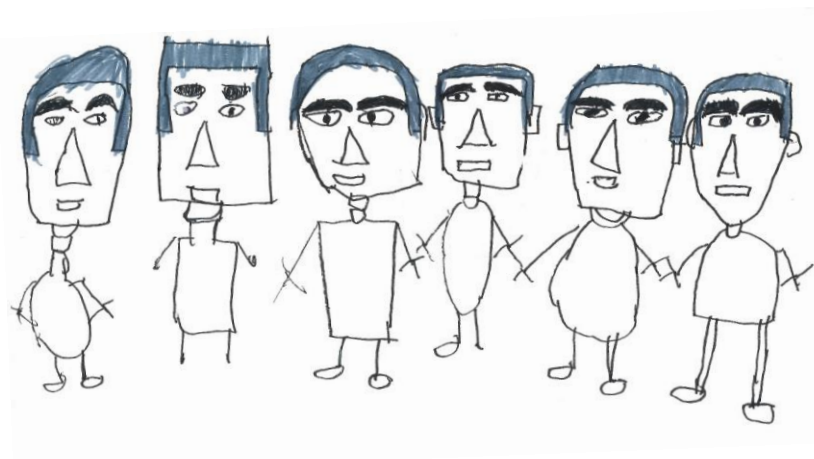
